Mentoring Coalition Forms to Benefit Students

PORT ST. LUCIE, FL – Several local organizations and individuals have formed a coalition to mentor high school students to enhance their future opportunities. They will be given an opportunity to visit the local businesses and in some cases internships and summer jobs will be available.
